Questions People May Have When Biospecimens Are Studied in Research

The following questions are commonly asked by potential research subjects.

- QUESTION: Where/how are the samples being stored?
 - ANSWER: Before the biospecimens are collected, containers are labeled with a number that is unique to you. Your name is not on the label. Once collected, the samples are taken to our laboratory. The laboratory will immediately begin testing some of the samples. The samples that are not tested immediately, will be placed in storage at the TRI-MD Laboratory Room 2404.
- QUESTION: Will I get results from the testing done on biospecimens I have given?
 - ANSWER: Most research with biospecimens is not expected to yield new information that would be meaningful to share with you personally. Because of this, there are no plans to re-contact you or other subjects with information about research results.
- QUESTIONS: What type of testing will they do more specifically?
 - ANSWER:
- QUESTION: Who is performing the testing?
 - ANSWER: The Principal Investigator (PI) may conduct the testing, but may also assign some of the testing to members of the research team. Before being allowed to perform testing, research team members must demonstrate that they are skilled and experienced to perform the testing so that accurate results are obtained. Sometimes, we may need to send some of your samples to outside laboratories for testing that cannot be conducted at AH.
- QUESTION: How do I know the results won't be released to my insurance company or someone else?
 - ANSWER: Your information will be kept confidential and only released to the people or entities listed on this form.
