Scope	All personnel expending effort on programs funded by federal or state grants and privately funded grants that require time and effort reporting.
Purpose	This policy defines how Compliance with Federal and State regulations as well as terms and conditions of grant awards that require time and effort certification. Compliance is measured through and annual audit by an external CPA firm in AdventHealth Orlando's Financial Statements (A-133 Audit).
Policy	All personnel who have expended effort on a grant will certify their effort by completing AdventHealth Orlando's Time and Effort Reports.
Definition (s)	Effort reporting : The method of documenting how an individual spent his/her time.
